TAMAVUA-I-WAI BRIDGE UNDERGOES ROUTINE MAINTENANCE WORKS

Fiji Roads Authority (FRA) would like to advise members of the public that traffic will be reduced to single lane only under a managed stop / go arrangement on the Tamavua-I-Wai Bridge on Queens Road outside Suva.

Works will commence from 9.00pm Saturday, November 11th on the lane closure for Suva bound traffic. In conjunction with necessary periodic inspections, minor surface repairs will be carried out and the lane will remain closed till 8.00am Sunday, 12th November.

The FRA acknowledges that this bridge is a key link to the Suva City and the Port and as such the high level of emphasis is placed to keep the traffic moving with minimal disruption.

Members of the public travelling along this area to take this notice into account when finalising travel plans.
