Northern Division

- Nakobo Road, Cakaudrove is closed due to flooding.
- Buca Bay Road, Cakaudrove- road has been reduced to single lane due to a slip

Eastern Division

- Navaga Crossing located on Koro Circular Road in the Eastern Division is closed to all traffic.
The bridge abutment has collapsed and major scouring has occurred near the bridge approach following the heavy down pour. Public are advised to use alternative route via Navaga Village.
